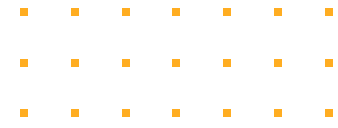

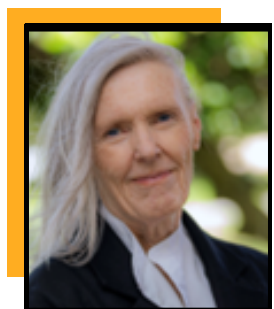


Dr. Anita Borja Enriquez
President, University of Guam

Dr. Anita Borja Enriquez became the 12th President of the University of Guam August 2023. Previously, she served as the Senior Vice President and Provost at UOG for ten years. Over her 30-year career at UOG, Dr. Enriquez has held other administrative positions, including serving as the first CHamoru Dean of the UOG School of Business and Public Administration and Interim Director of the Center for Continuing Education and Outreach Programs. In addition to her career in academia, Dr. Enriquez has extensive private sector experience in organizational management and marketing and as an entrepreneur. She believes her careers in private enterprise and public service fuels her passion for workforce and economic development for the island and the rest of Micronesia. Enriquez holds a Bachelor of Science in Management from University of Maryland Global Campus, a Master of Business Administration from the University of Guam, and a Doctor of Business Administration in International Business Administration (Marketing) from Alliant International University.

Keynote Speaker

Dr. Roseann Jones is a tenured Professor of Economics and Dean of the School of Business and Public Administration at the University of Guam. She received her Ph.D. in economics and regional planning from the University of Pennsylvania. She is an institutional economist specializing in development economics, with subspecialty research in health care and environmental policy. Dr. Jones holds a Master of Arts degree in City and Regional Planning and a Master of Government Administration from the Samuel Fels Center of Government at the University of Pennsylvania. Dr. Jones's research focuses on regional economic development, initially with national studies of the US health system and implications for its workforce. She has more recently conducted economic impact studies of Guam's economy, its labor force, and productivity.
